

Das present perfect **SB** p. 75

Mit dem *present perfect* drückt man aus, dass jemand irgendwann etwas getan hat oder dass irgendwann etwas geschehen ist. Der genaue Zeitpunkt des Geschehens ist unwichtig.

a) Bejahte Aussagesätze

have/has + 3. Form des Verbs (past participle)

- Bei regelmäßigen Verben hängst du *-ed* an den Infinitiv, um das *past participle* zu bilden:
play + ed → played visit + ed → visited
- Die *past participle*-Formen der unregelmäßigen Verben musst du lernen (**SB** p. 253).

b) Verneinte Aussagesätze

Verneinte Aussagesätze werden mit *have not (haven't)* bzw. *has not (hasn't)* und dem *past participle* gebildet.

I **haven't visited** Las Vegas.
She **hasn't visited** Las Vegas.

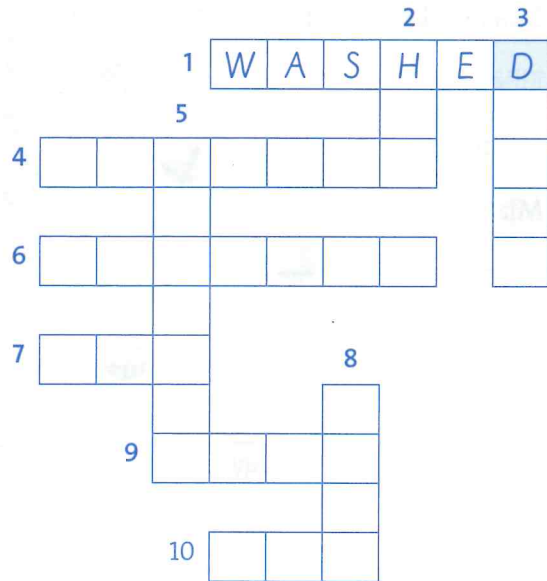

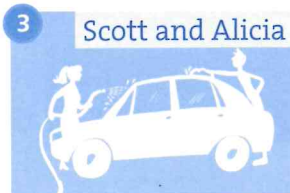
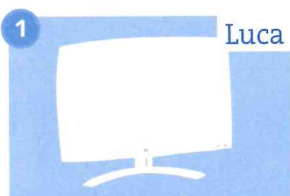
